



Fall 2009 Sketch Club

September 16	Meet at the BF for a short demo by Mary Lou on "Bob's blobs", a technique of Robert Wade's for painting people in crowds. Then we'll go to Waterloo Town Square and practice on passersby! Bring w/c equipment.
September 23	Meet in the parking lot at Huron Nature Area. We'll try to capture the Fall colours.
September 30	Mary Lou will discuss a technique to create an unforgettable picture! Bring drawing paper, tracing paper, pencil, eraser, and an interesting (for shape) fruit, vegetable, or flower, preferably with some of its stem and leaves. * At noon be prepared to pick up your paintings in the Sketch Club show and transport them to Luther Village where we will store them in the chapel before hanging them. A volunteer group will hang them at 4:30.
October 7	Meet at Nauman's "Pumpkins Galore" display. Bring your preferred medium and a chair. If weather doesn't permit, we'll meet at the BF and continue our work from the previous week. If you were away we can catch you up. (Look at Sept 30 for materials needed)
October 14	"Painting Rescue Techniques" will be discussed by Helen, Frances Gregory, and Pat Kalyn. Bring in your duds and try to save them!
October 21	Masa Paper Floral Still Life-Mar Lou will demonstrate how to prepare the masa paper. (about 50 cents to \$1 each) Bring w/c paper and pencil and eraser to draw the floral still life. To be completed next week!
October 28	Masa Paper Floral Still Life- bring prepared masa paper . Paint the floral arrangement with w/c. Bring w/c and brushes. If you missed last week, just paint the still life on w/c paper.
November 4	Costumed model. Bring your favourite medium. (African drummer)
November 11	Portraits! Focus on another club member and do their portrait in your chosen medium.
November 18	Architectural Mood Painting- Bring a favourite photo and do a 'moody' rendition. Drop in a few 'blob' people for effect! Bring your chosen medium.
November 25	Meet at the Church of St. Louis on Allen St. We'll work inside. Bring favourite medium. (I will email new plans if a funeral takes precedence)
December 2	A "Junk Treasures" Still Life- Bring interesting items for the study-the older and rustier, the better! (tools and antiques would work well) Bring preferred medium. Pat Kalyn will be leading the group)
December 9	"China and Lace" Still Life- Bring china dolls, china tea cups and saucers, teapots, vases, candlesticks, lace cloths, etc. for the Still Life. Bring preferred medium. Jan will present a short intro highlighting Arleta Pech's watercolours.
December 16	Pot Luck and Planning meeting. Bring your ideas for the Winter Session!
