
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About the Juror: Judy Major - Girardin

She is a recently retired Professor from the School of the Arts at McMaster University where she taught for 39 years. She lives in Cambridge Ontario and has served as Co-Chair of the Cambridge Sculpture Garden since 2005. Her studio work includes an integrated practise of painting, printmaking, drawing, artist books, and fiber-based works that raise awareness for the preservation and celebration of wetland environments. She has exhibited throughout Canada and the USA and internationally through exhibitions in New Zealand, Portugal, and Taiwan.

Artist Statement

My interest in printmaking is less concerned with the process of achieving multiple, identical images and is more involved with exploring the unique qualities of print processes and the variation that printing with a matrix can achieve. I am currently immersed in printing on fabric panels and combining this with sewing and fabric collage in preparation for a solo show at Idea Exchange in Cambridge that opens in May 2024. I am an advocate for safer and more environmentally responsible approaches in printmaking and have attended non-toxic print residencies at Zea Mays Printmaking in Massachusetts and at Wharepuke Print Studio in New Zealand.

- Entrants are encouraged to use simple framing.
- Only work not previously shown by BFA will be accepted.
- The artist must firmly attach ONE label to the BACK of their work indicating name, title, medium and price. Do not label the front side for jurying purposes.
- Work that does not meet the criteria will not be accepted for entry.
- All work left 60 days beyond pick-up date becomes the property of Button Factory Arts.
